

HOW DO I OBTAIN A BREAST PUMP?

- Most breast pumps are provided free of charge by your insurance company.
 Obtaining a breast pump prior to delivery can be an easy process.
- You will need to contact your insurance company to find out what durable medical equipment (DME) facility will provide you with your breast pump.
- Once you have decided on which facility to obtain your breast pump, you will need to contact them to discuss what type or style of breast pump is right for you.
- The facility will often contact us for the order for the breast pump. If not, an order can be provided to you via the patient portal or at your next office visit.

WHEN SHOULD I CONTACT MY INSURANCE COMPANY?

- The best time to contact your insurance company is the end of your second trimester.
- Most insurance companies or facilities will provide you with the breast pump at that time.
